**The training program accepts applications from candidates who are pursuing degrees in Health Psychology, School Psychology, Clinical Psychology, Counseling Psychology or Education. Candidates selected for a postdoctoral residency position must have completed all requirements for a doctoral degree from an APA-accredited doctoral program prior to the training program's start date. Candidates selected for a postdoctoral position must also have completed an internship at an APA-accredited or APPIC-member program by the time their residency begins. In addition, their doctoral degree must be conferred by December 31st of the same year in which residency begins.**

**Describe any other required minimum criteria used to screen applicants:**

**All qualified candidates must have the legal right to work in the United States without current or future employer sponsorship; which includes but is not limited to H-1B, TN, AC-21, O-1, E-3, F-1, OPT or F-1 CPT. All applicants must apply through the APPA CAS portal. Since this is a training program, we cannot accept an applicant who has or will have completed a postdoctoral residency and/or achieved licensure.**
